Considerate Parking

We have received numerous reports from local residents regarding inconsiderate and dangerous parking (especially in side roads). Severe Weather Warnings

Our school will remain open unless it is judged unsafe to do so or if we do not have sufficient staff to allow us to open safely. However, if the school needs to close, a decision will be taken as early in the morning as possible and the school website will be updated and a message sent via the School Gateway App (please ensure that you remain logged in).

We ask that parents do not phone the school for information about closure as this is likely to block phone lines.

Reporting illness/absence

Reporting Absences/Illness - Just a quick message to thank everyone who keeps the school updated when their children are unwell. This is a reminder that any absence should be reported, **with full details of illness/symptoms please**, before 9.30am; either via an email to the office, a telephone call to the absence line or via the Gateway App.

Absences During Term Time - It is a legal requirement for permission to be sought from the Head Teacher if you are planning to take your child out of school during term time. To comply, an absence request form **must** be submitted via the school office **before a booking is made**, giving reasons for your request. Please note that **unauthorised** holiday absence of 5 days or more (either as a block or as separate days), within each academic year, will automatically be referred to the Local Authority with a request that a Penalty Notice be issued.
