English

Maths

In Maths this half term, we are describing movement and turns. We are also going to be multiplying and dividing. We will learn more about the 2, 5 and 10 times table. We will look at odd and even numbers. We will also recap our doubling and halving skills.

Bottling &

Science

Our big question in science this half term is 'What do humans need to survive?' We will look at lifecycles and how animals and humans grow. We will discuss the importance of a healthy and balanced diet. We will discuss why we need exercise. We will also learn about the importance of hygiene and how we can keep our bodies clean.

Art

In Art this half term, we will be learning about the sculptor Barbara Hepworth. We will discuss which of her works we like and dislike. We will use clay to make simple thumb pots and learn how to use different techniques to manipulate clay. We will also look at the work 'Rush of Nature' by Marc Quinn. We will compare his work to the work of Barbara Hepworth.

Geography

In geography, we will continue our learning about the UK. We will learn about Wales and Northern Irelands. We will learn key facts like the capital city of each country and emblems associated with each country. We will then learn about the 7 continents of the world. We will learn a song to help us remember them. We will also learn the names of the 5 oceans.

PSHE

In PSHE, we will be celebrating differences. We will be improving our teamwork skills by taking part in group challenges. We will discuss how it feels to achieve something. We will discuss setting realistic goals and discuss how we can achieve these.

\mathbf{DT}

In DT, we will begin our learning on Solid Structures this half term. We will look at natural and man made structures and use vocabulary like stable and strong to describe structures. We will be inspired by the Three Billy Goats Gruff. We will design and build a bridge for the goats to use to cross the river. We will use sugar cubes to make our bridges.

Computing and RE

In computing, we will be improving our coding skills. We will be creating and debugging simple programs on Scratchjr.

In RE, We are learning about the Islamic faith. We will learn some of the key Muslim beliefs about Allah and discuss some of the ways that Muslims show their faith.

History

In History, we are going back in time to 1666 to learn about the Great Fire of London. We will make a timeline of the key events of the fire. We will learn about key historical figures like Samuel Pepys. We will discuss how the fire started and stopped. We will discuss the impact the fire had on London. We will use historical sources and artefacts to find out about the fire.

PE and Music

In indoor PE, we will be moving our bodies to music. We will be creating some simple dances inspired by the Great Fire of London. In outdoor PE, we will be participating in team games and developing simple tactics.

In music, we will be using our voices expressively and using some instruments. We will be learning a song called 'I wanna play in a band'.
