This term we will be -

Using these sounds to read and write words.

The children will be practicing reading longer - multisyllabic words like, cartoon, pumpkin.

We will also be continuing to support the children with their writing of phrases, captions and short simple sentences.

To achieve the end of year expectations children need to be able to write a simple sentence.

- continue to develop their counting skills, counting larger sets as well as counting actions and sounds

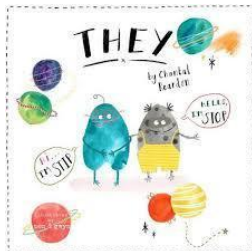
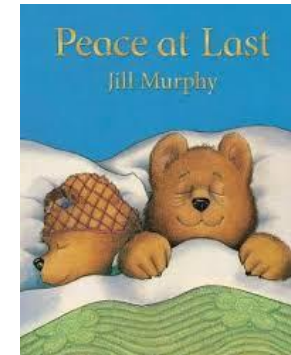
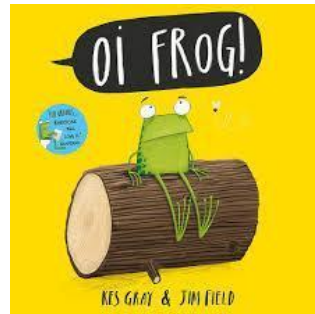
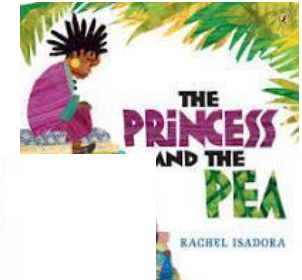
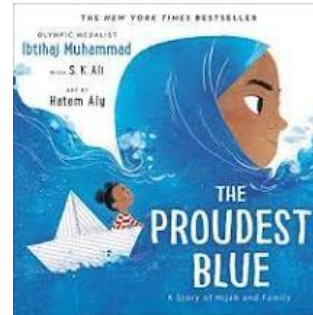
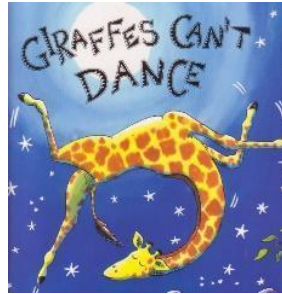
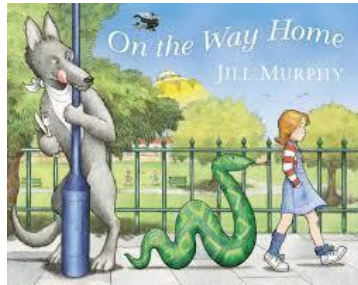
- explore a range of representations of numbers, including the 10-frame, and see how doubles can be arranged in a 10-Frame.

- compare quantities and numbers, including sets of objects, which have different attributes

- continue to develop a sense of magnitude, e.g. knowing that 8 is quite a lot more than 2, but 4 is only a little bit more than 2.
